• **DIVISION REQUIREMENTS**

- Four or more teams are required in order to form a division.

• **EVALUATION INFORMATION (Required to attend, those unable to attend are subject to random team assignment)**

- **Players trying out are encouraged to wear cleats, however tennis shoes will be permitted for evaluations only.**

• **GAME LOCATIONS**

- Depending on the number of teams in each age division, games may be scheduled for West Walton Park (Loganville), Criswell Park (Monroe), or South Walton Park (Social Circle).

• **EQUIPMENT NEEDED**

- Provided: Hat and game jersey (included in registration fee)
- Not Provided: Pants, socks, cleats, glove, USSSA approved baseball bat, batting helmet (facemask optional)

• **IMPORTANT DATES**

- February 18th – Practice begins
- March 18th – Opening Day
- March 10th – 11th Picture Day on Legion Field (tentative)
- May 20th-25th (tentative) – County wide end of season tournament

• **ALL – STARS**

- Baseball will participate in USSSA All – Stars (ages 5 – 14)
- There will not be All – Stars for the 15 - 18 year old division
- All-Star team players age 5U – 8U shall not have participated on a “travel” team of higher classification than AAA (i.e.; Major) after January 1st of the current season year.
- All-Star team players age 9U – 18U shall not have participated on a “travel” team of higher classification than AA (i.e.; AAA, Major) after January 1st of the current season year.
- All – Star players will be required to pay a \$30 All – Star fee
